
Dear Parents/Carers,

You could do this around your home and put different objects in size order.

You could look for worms in the garden or the park.
- Exploring our new Vets area.
You could talk to your child about why animals go to the Vets and how we could look after them. You could also help your child to learn the names of some new animals.

You could involve your child in cooking or baking at home.
