

Story of the week



This week we will be reading Dinosaurs Galore!

This week we will also be:

- Making dinosaur models and resources for our dinosaur cave.

You could help your child by reading dinosaur books and thinking about what they looked like and what might have been around when they were alive.

- Investigating for signs of dinosaur activity in the Nursery.

You could talk to your child about what they might expect to see if dinosaurs were roaming the Nursery!

- Making dinosaur smoothies.

You could help your child by making smoothies together at home and talking about how to stay healthy.

- Hunting for numbers

You could help by looking at digits 1-10 and making sure the children know the number name for each one.

Phonics

We are continuing to listen for the initial sounds in words and we are trying to write these sounds down. It is really important that the children understand that the sound they hear is represented with a 'symbol'.



This week we will be thinking about where we see God's love around us. We will be thinking about our friendship groups in Nursery and how we can be a good friend to others. We will be trying to play with different children that we normally do not play with and remembering to share with each other.

You could help your child at home by playing some turn taking games, talking to them about their friends and encouraging them to play with different children.
