

### Incidents between children

Please could you let a member of the Nursery staff know if your child has had any fall out with another child so that we can deal with it. There have been a few occasions lately where we have noticed parents talking to other children trying to sort things out. This puts the staff in a very difficult position (especially if it is done in a home language that we do not speak). We would appreciate it if you allowed us to deal with sensitive matters.

### This week we will also be:

- Developing imagination by making rockets and planets for our very own solar system. You could allow your child to use empty boxes and recycling materials to make models to support their imaginative play.
- Writing in our dark space area. You could support your child's writing at home by writing their name together or drawing pictures together.
- Making lemon star shaped biscuits. You could bake together using a recipe and measuring out ingredients.
- Planting seeds in a pot ready to take home at half term. Talk to your child about what plants need to grow, water them together if you have any at home or try to spot some in the park or on the way to Nursery.

In RE we are continuing our 'New Life' topic. This week we will be focusing on the message that Jesus left us his joy and peace. We will be thinking about ways we can spread his love to others.

We will also be trying to recall the story we know so far, all the way back to Palm Sunday. I am so impressed with how much the children know about Jesus' life and death and a number of parents have also commented on it to me.
